Conditions of Entry

1. Introduction

The **Royal Flying Doctor Service of Australia (RFDS)** is a not-for-profit charity providing free emergency and healthcare services across regional and remote Australia. The RFDS relies on donations from individuals, businesses, and community groups, as well as government funding, to operate 24/7.

On The Road Again Tours (OTRA) is a bi-annual motoring event that raises funds for the RFDS in WA. Each year, participants drive a mystery route through regional WA.

2. Terms and Conditions

By entering the event, participants agree to follow all **Official Conditions of Entry** set by the **OTRA Event Organisers**.

3. Code of Conduct

All participants must behave in a **safe, respectful, and responsible** manner throughout the event.

General Conduct

- Always act appropriately and avoid offensive behaviour.
- Respect fellow participants, volunteers, and the public.
- Follow all instructions from the **Event Organisers**.
- Obey all laws, including the **WA Road Traffic Code 2018**.

Immediate Removal

Participants may be removed without warning for:

- Criminal behaviour.
- Actions that endanger others or the event.
- Driving with a positive alcohol reading.

Warnings or Dismissal

Participants may receive one warning before removal for:

- Bringing OTRA's name into disrepute.
- Offensive behaviour.
- Acts of vandalism.
- Ignoring reasonable directions from officials.

Note: Removed participants may be banned from future events.

Additional Conditions

- The Event Organisers may issue extra rules or instructions at any time.
- These may be communicated in writing or verbally.
- All participants must comply.

Final Authority

The **Event Coordinator's** decision on any matter is **final**.

4. Rules and Regulations

Rules may be updated at any time by the **OTRA Event Organisers**.

4.1 Entry

- Entry is **personal and non-transferable** and non-refundable. Entry fee minus expenses will be deposited into participants fundraising account.
- The **Entrant** is the person(s) listed on the entry form, not the vehicle.
- Entries are accepted at the Organiser's discretion.

4.2 Eligibility

- All drivers must hold a **current driver's licence**

4.3 Fees and Donations

Item	Amount
OTRA Membership	\$50
Minimum RFDS Donation	\$500 per tour
Meals, Entertainment & Awards Levy (per person)	Amount is variable depending on length of tour

Payments must be made before the commencement of the tour. Monies deposited into **OTRA Operating Account: 633 000 – 174 544 155**

4.6 Route

- The **Event Organisers** plans the route to ensure it is safe, scenic, and enjoyable.
- The route may change at any time due to weather or other conditions.
- Alternative routes may be arranged in consultation with councils or landowners.

5. Vehicles

5.1 Insurance & Registration

Participants must have:

- Vehicle insurance (minimum: **third-party**).
- Vehicle **registration**.
- **Driver's licence**.

5.2 Vehicle Preparation

- Participants are responsible for all vehicle preparation, maintenance, and repairs.

5.3 Vehicle Signage

All vehicles must display:

- **OTRA car number stickers** on both front doors (provided).
- **OTRA sash** across the top of the windscreen (provided).

All vehicles must be registered, insured, and roadworthy.

6. Fundraising and Sponsorship

Participants are encouraged to raise as much as possible for the **RFDS**.

6.1 Fundraising Rules

- All funds raised must be **officially receipted** by OTRA Tours Inc.
- Mark your **entry number** on all donations.

7. During the Event

The event is a **celebration of your fundraising efforts** — enjoy it!

7.1 A Typical Day

Example schedule:

- 7:30 am – Breakfast
- 8:30 am – Start
- 12:00 pm – Lunch
- 4:00 pm – Overnight stop
- 7:00 pm – Briefing & fines
- 7:15 pm – Dinner & entertainment

Checkpoints occur at:

- Morning departure
- Lunch arrival/departure
- Evening arrival
- **YOU MUST REPORT into these checkpoints either in person, via WhatsApp or radio**

At day's end:

1. Refuel your vehicle
2. Check into accommodation
3. Attend briefing
4. Dinner, entertainment & socialising

7.3 Route Instructions

- Do not leave the set route without permission.
- If you need to leave, an event organiser member must be notified.
- Route Notes use the following abbreviations:
 - **TR/TL** – Turn Right / turn left
 - **KL/KR** – Keep Left / keep right
 - **VR/VL**: veer right / veer left
 - **SO** – Straight On
 - **CC** – Double Caution (slow down)
 - **CCC** – Stop and look before proceeding

7.4 Route Markers

Markers include:

- **Red arrow** – direction of travel
- **CC** – double caution (slow to 5–9 km/h)
- **CCC** – extreme caution (stop before proceeding)

8. Fun Rules

The most important rule: **Have fun!**

8.1 Cheating & Bribery

- Cheating and bribery are **encouraged** — but getting caught may cost you!
- “Fines” are treated as **donations to the RFDS**.
- Bribes can be given to officials in cash or electronic donation.
- A bigger bribe may cancel out a smaller one!

8.2 Attitude

- Don't take yourself too seriously — fines apply for being too serious!
- Some participants budget extra for fines and bribes — they're tax-deductible donations.

8.4 Protests

- Protests require a cheque (amount set by the Event Organisers).
- Decisions by the Event Organisers are **final**.
- The outcome may depend on the size of your “additional donation”!
